Snowpark Rules

Use of the Snowpark is fun, but the park is only intended for experienced winter sportsmen with suitable sports equipment. You use the park at your own risk. You are responsible for your own insurance cover. We list below the 4 most important rules for use of the park.

1. LOOK FIRST, JUMP SECOND You should inspect all obstacles before using the park. Make sure that there are no obstructions in the landing area. You must leave the landing area as soon as possible after landing.

2. PLAN YOUR RUN

Speed, approach and jump have a direct influence on the trick and landing. Before starting, consider how you want to tackle each obstacle

3. TAKE IT SLOWLY

Park users, especially inexperienced users, should start with the small obstacles and acquire the necessary skills for the larger ones (medium to large).

4. RESPECT EARNS RESPECT

Other park users and nature must be respected. Do not endanger other park users; obey the park rules; leave no litter.

Small obstacles small

These obstacles are low and easily manageable (even for Snowpark beginners).

Start small and work your way up.
